

Plastic Free Chepstow Summer Challenge

The small print – Terms and Conditions

- 1. The competition is open to young people aged 11-18 who live in or around Chepstow (NP16 postal district) or attend school in Chepstow. You can enter as an individual or a team.*
- 2. Your entry must be your own work, not previously displayed or performed in public, and must not infringe anyone else's copyright.*
- 3. Each entry must be accompanied by an entry form. You can enter at any time after 15th August and the closing date for entries is **Friday 6 September 2019 at 6pm**. Entry forms should be accompanied in a separate email by a photograph, sound recording or video of your work using a standard format and should be submitted to plasticfree@transitionchepstow.org.uk Alternatively, you can submit via Facebook Messenger to Plastic-Free Chepstow. Entries limited to one per person/team.*
- 4. Prizes will be awarded as follows: 2 prizes of £50 each for the best entries by 11-14 year olds; 2 prizes of £50 each for the best entries by 15-18 year olds; 2 prizes of £100 each for the best team entries. In addition, the entrant or team who, in the judges' opinion, provides the most effective message will be invited to a working session with Monmouthshire County Council's professional graphics/design team.*
- 5. The judges will be looking for an original piece of work which grabs people's attention, has a clear message, and encourages people to act responsibly. Both the quality of the creative work and the statement in the entry form will be considered.*
- 6. Winners will be notified on or before 7 October 2019.*
- 7. The copyright of the work will remain with the entrant but, by submitting your work, you give permission for Transition Chepstow, Monmouthshire County Council and Keep Wales Tidy to use it for publicity and promotional activities and in social media campaigns.*
