Monmouthshire Meadows has the opportunity to safeguard the future of two beautiful, species-rich hay meadows in the heart of the county.

The two meadows used to be part of Kingcoed Farm. Originally semi-improved and rather species poor, they have been sympathetically managed by their current owners for 12 years. As a result, Spotted Orchids, Southern Marsh Orchids, Knapweed, Common Cat's Ear, Rough Hawkbit, Bird's-foot Trefoil, Tufted Vetch and many other plants have colonised and spread. In wet areas a diversity of rushes and sedges has appeared, and even Adder's-tongue Fern. However, the owners are now selling the land.



We want to safeguard this important site from agricultural 'improvement', to preserve and enhance the biodiversity of the area. We plan to use the site for events and educational activities, to demonstrate what can be achieved with the right management regime.
